Iowa law requires that written notification must be given to the assessor upon conveyance of this property.

The following persons are now eligible for military service property tax exemption: Honorably discharged veteran who served in an eligible service period or served for a minimum aggregate of at least 18 months or fewer than 18 months because of a service-related injury; former member, or member who is currently serving, of Reserve Forces or Iowa National Guard who has served at least 20 years or was activated for federal duty, not including training, for a minimum of 90 days; Former member of the Armed Forces whose enlistment would have occurred during the Korean conflict but chose to serve 5 years in the Reserved Forces; Spouse, Unmarried widow(er), Minor Child, or Widowed parent of the qualified Veteran.

**SMOKE DETECTOR AND HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION APPLICATION**
